Northern Red Oak	Moist to Mod. Dry	F to P	8-16 X 16	75 – 100	M to F	Tree provides denning, nesting sites and acorns are excellent food for wildlife.
Red Splendor Crab	S to CL	F	8 X 8	20 – 25	F	Great for wildlife!
Red Maple	S to C	F to PS	8-16 X 16	50 – 70	M	Bright red fall foliage
Norway (Red) Pine	S to SC	F/P	9 X 9	75 – 100	F	MAMMOTH! The Minnesota State Tree
White Pine	LS to CL	F/P	9 X 9	75 – 100	F	Classic beauty...just watch for insects or disease.
White Cedar	SL to C	F/P	3 X 3 (hedge) 9 X 9 (tree)	30 – 60	M	Great windbreak but protect from deer and rabbits.
White Spruce	L to C	F/P/S	8 X 9	50 – 75	M	Long lived forest tree.
Jack Pine	S to SL	F	9 X 9	50 – 65	F	Fast growing pine used for pulpwood. Grows well in dry rocky or sandy area where other trees can't.
Black Spruce	S to C	F to P	8 X 9	30 – 60	S	Excellent tree for very wet sites and grows rapidly on well-drained and moist bottomlands. Improved stock grown from seed selected from trees with superior growth and pest resistance characteristics.
Tamarack	S to L	F/P	8 X 9	80 – 100	M	Grows well in a wide variety of sites.
American High Bush Cranberry	SL to C	F/P	6 X 6	8 – 12	M	Wonderful jellies and juices!
American Mountain Ash	S to C	F to PS	6 X 6	10 – 30	S to M	Bright red berries last into the winter, attractive to birds.
American Plum	SL to SC	F	6 X 6	12 - 20	F	Tasty Jams!
Black Chokeberry	S to C	F to PS	6 x 6	6 - 15	S	Glabrous leaves and stems. Tends to sucker profusely forming large colonies.
Common Chokecherry	Rich moist soil	F to S	3-6 X 10	12 – 25	F	White flowers and tart, purplish fruit used in jellies and pies. Wildlife such as songbirds, grouse, pheasant, raccoon, bear, fox, deer, cottontail rabbit and squirrels feed on twigs and fruit
Pin Cherry	S to SL	F	7 x 7	25 - 30	F	Fruit is excellent for Jams. Very tolerant of poorly drained soils. Leaves contain cyanide.
Red Osier Dogwood	S	F to PS	3-6 x 10	7 – 10	F	Fruit and twigs used by robins, cedar waxwings, rabbits, and deer. Twigs are red, providing winter color and dense wildlife cover.
Serviceberry (Juneberry)	L to SL	F to PS	3-6 X 10	6 – 20	M	Edible berry used by songbirds, grouse, mourning doves, skunk, beaver, fox, bear, squirrels.
Villosa Lilac	S to CL	F	6 X 6	6 – 12	M	Resembles the common lilac but non-suckering.
Four Season Wildlife Packet	S to C	F to S	3-6X 10	7 - 25	M to F	Excellent year round wildlife food source Consider planting in small groups with conifers
